### What is ARCA?

The American Rehabilitation Counseling Association's mission is to enhance the development of people with disabilities throughout the life span and to promote excellence in the rehabilitation counseling profession. ARCA's goal is to provide leadership that will encourage excellence in rehabilitation counseling practice, research, consultation, and professional development. ARCA is equally interested in changing environmental conditions so more opportunities are available in education, employment, and community activities to people with disabilities. This is accomplished through public education and legislative action.

### Who Joins ARCA?

ARCA is an organization of professional rehabilitation counselors and rehabilitation counseling students concerned with improving the lives of people with disabilities.

Rehabilitation counselors assist people with physical, mental, or social disabilities to maximize their potential. They accomplish this by managing the rehabilitation process which includes counseling, casefinding, assessment, training, and placement activities. Rehabilitation counselors also assess the environment, recommend modifications, and work to build a positive interaction between people with disabilities and their surroundings. Rehabilitation counselors are employed in both public and private sectors, and their career opportunities are continually expanding to a variety of new settings.

### Types of Membership

**Professional:** Individuals who hold a master's degree or higher in counseling or a closely related field from a college or university accredited by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.

**Regular:** Individuals whose interests and activities are consistent with those of ACA, but who are not qualified for professional membership.

**New Professional:** A New Professional is someone who has graduated with a masters or a doctorate within the past 12 months. Status is good for one year.

**Student:** Individuals who are enrolled at least half-time in a college or university program.

**Retired:** Members who are retired from the counseling profession and have been active ACA members for the past 5 consecutive years.

#### Division Processing Fee

To join ARCA without joining ACA, a processing fee of \$10 will apply.
